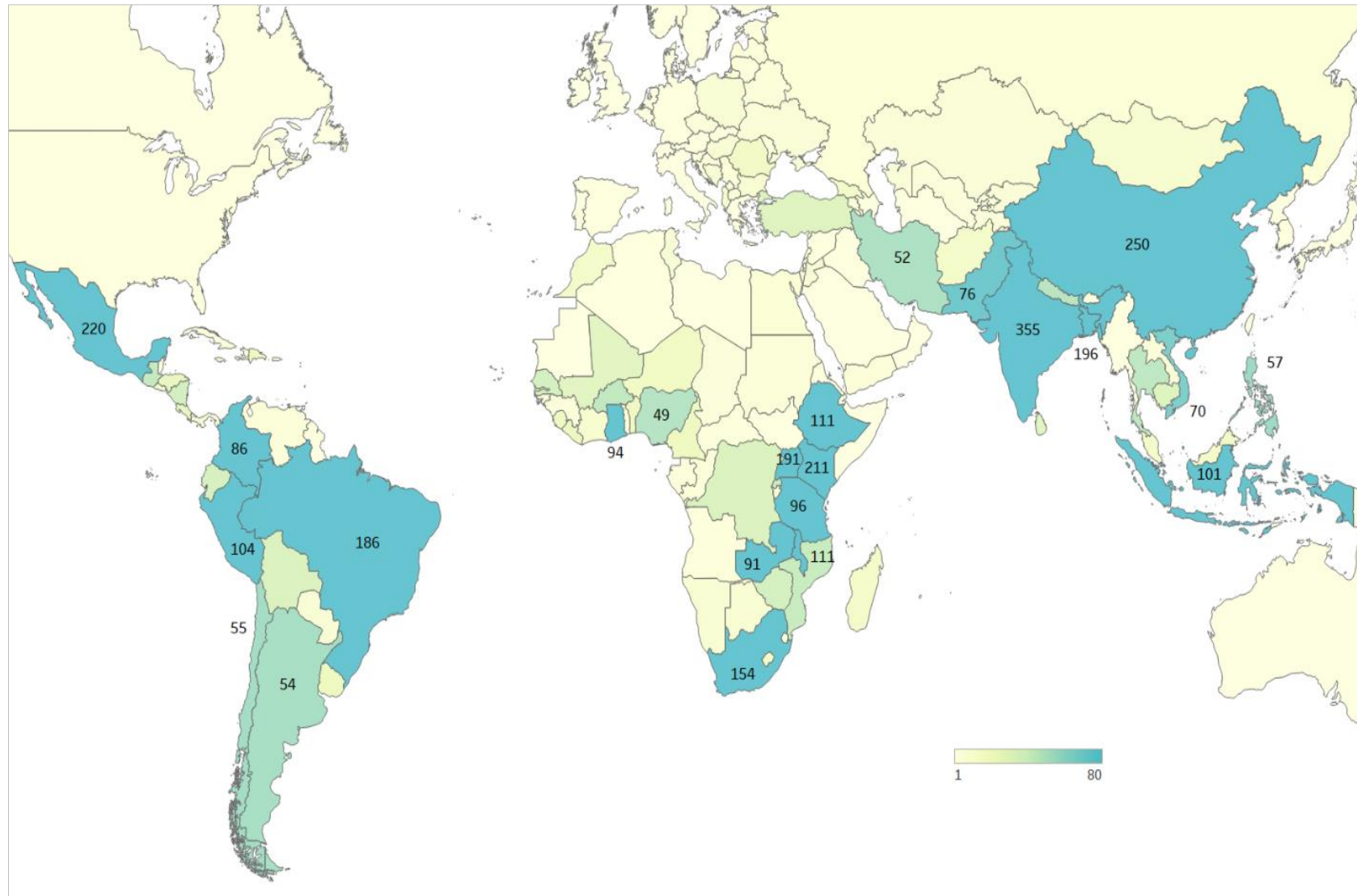

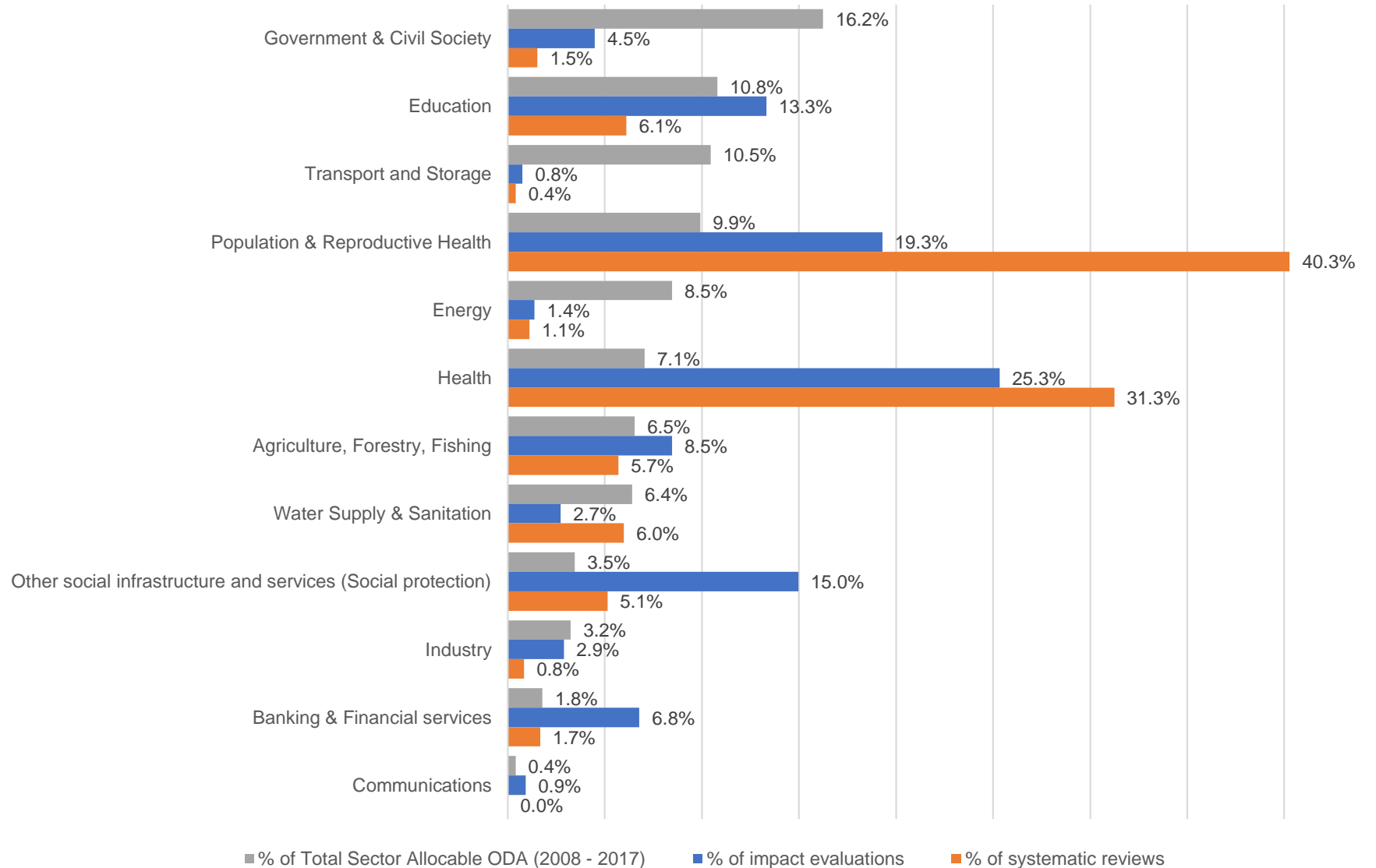

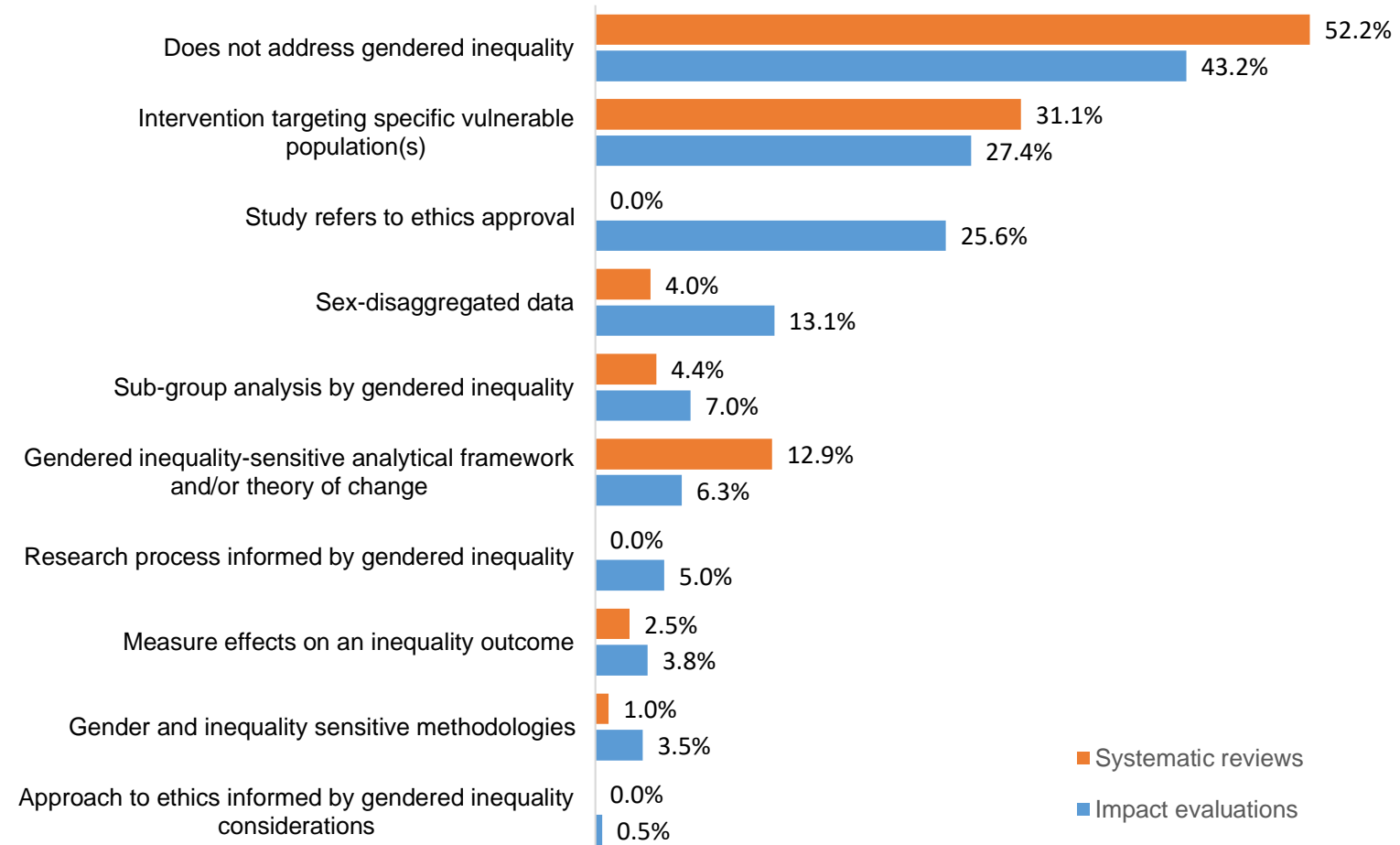
Distribution of studies highly uneven
